**National Security Subcommittee to Hold September 22nd Hearing on
The 9/11 Commission Recommendations and National Strategies**

(Washington, DC) -- Congressman Christopher Shays (R-CT), Chairman of the Subcommittee on National Security, Emerging Threats, and International Relations, will convene an oversight hearing September 22 to examine the recommendations of *The National Commission on Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States* (9/11 Commission) as they relate to the goals, objectives and initiatives of the 2002 *National Strategy for Homeland Security* and the 2003 *National Strategy to Combat Terrorism*.

The hearing, "Combating Terrorism: The 9/11 Commission Recommendations and the National Strategies," will be held Wednesday, September 22, 10 am, room 2247 Rayburn House Office Building in Washington, D.C.

A unanimous 9/11 Commission made 41 recommendations, and called for "reflection and reevaluation" of U.S. strategies against terrorism at home and abroad. This hearing will examine the extent to which 9/11 Commission strategic recommendations are already reflected in counterterrorism policy statements and which need to be included in long-term strategies.
